## **January Speaker Information**

**Speaker:** Mason Hintermeister

Title of Talk: "Sharks, Fieldwork, and AI: An

Undergraduate at Work"

Mason Hintermeister is an undergraduate researcher in the final year of his B.S. in Human Evolutionary Biology and Anthropology at Stony Brook University. As a member of the Functional Morphology Lab, he studies the evolution of fossil primates in East Africa. Mason is also a member of Calvert Marine Museum Paleo Dive Team and an intern with the Thompson Earth Systems Institute working on AI applications to fossil shark teeth.

For much of the past 65 million years, the Atlantic coastal plain was ruled by sharks. Who are the people finding and recovering these fossils, what can these fossils unlock our past and our future, and how have they become a tool for ensuring children have the technical know-how to face the challenges of the modern world? Learn the answer to these questions and more with undergraduate researcher Mason Hintermeister as we explore Maryland's fossil sharks and their impact on the world.




